CEO's Report

A Journey of Hope and Transformation

It is a pleasure for me to present to you the 2024 Annual Report for Temcare.

At Temcare, our mission is to reflect Jesus' love through practical, compassionate support, offering hope to vulnerable families and individuals across Melbourne's eastern and southeastern suburbs and parts of regional Victoria.

We cannot do any of our work without our widespread support base. This includes our wonderful staff, our board of directors, volunteers, referring agencies and organisations, donors, church and business partners, faithful and long-term supporters, and most importantly, the friends of Temcare who pray for us.

I particularly highlight the contribution of our Chairman, Tim Morse, a man of God who I have grown to appreciate for his wisdom, his patience and his insightful advice.

As I reflect on our work in 2024, I am reminded of a timeless truth from Titus 3:4: "But when the kindness and love of God our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy."

This verse captures the heart of Temcare's calling—to extend mercy and kindness to those in need. Why? Simply because of who God is. He saves His people so they can do good toward others, as He has done to us.

This year, by the end of June 2024, we completed our operational restructure, which was started on the 3rd November 2023.

Operationally, we streamlined some

of our programs, reduced full-time staffing levels, added some new parttime staff, and introduced two new programs, NURTURE and HOPE.

Financially, we ended June 2024 with a profit of \$105,425, compared to a loss in the 2022/2023 financial year of (\$166,241).

During the period, we also continued our Respite Care, Mentoring, Food, CYC school holiday camp placements and our cherished and long-running annual Temcare Family Camp.

We continued to develop NURTURE, aiming to support mothers of young families, and HOPE, focusing on reaching out to families of prisoners.

We conducted two family camps on Philip Island, Island Time, and our traditional Temcare Family Camp, which has been running now for approximately 23 years, and was held at CYC The Island in March 2024.

The Family Camp was a great time of relaxation, fun activities, developing old and starting new friendships, hearty meals together, and a meaningful time of hearing about the free offer of eternal life available through Jesus Christ, and how having faith in Jesus can mean we and our loved ones who also trust Jesus can spend all eternity together in Heaven.

Each Temcare program is a testament to God's love, lifting those who feel forgotten, through practical love and care, whether it's a food bag, a respite placement, a mentoring session, a joyful school holiday or family camp experience, a Christmas hamper delivered, a phone call to catch up, or a message of hope.

Our work is not about grand gestures but about faithful, quiet acts of service. As Matthew 6:4 reminds us, "Your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you." At Temcare, we believe God sees every small act of love. Every volunteer's time, every donor's gift, every moment spent listening to a struggling parent or mentoring a youth.

These acts, often unseen by the world, are building a foundation of hope. Our volunteers embody this truth, serving with humility and dedication, ensuring our programs remain a safe haven for all, especially children.

The journey of faith is not about exerting our will but surrendering to God's. As we pray, "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:10), we are reminded that Temcare's impact flows from aligning with God's purpose.

Sometimes this means changing course, adapting, and embracing the changes God brings about. This can

be difficult, but done in trust, it will always be for the best.

This year, we've expanded our reach, with additional plans to encourage and empower disadvantaged youth and single or struggling parents with young children.

As we look to 2024/2025, I invite you to join us in this work. Your support, whether through donations, volunteering, or prayer, fuels our mission.

Together, let's continue to reflect God's mercy, trusting that He who never changes will transform lives through us.

About Temcare

In its various forms, Temcare has been serving families and individuals in Victoria since approximately 1968 and presently operates from offices in Ringwood North.

What is Temcare?

It is a professionally operated Christian community support agency, that reflects the love of Jesus in our wider community in many practical ways. It is a Christian mission organization whose mission ground is right here in Victoria. It is a mercy ministry that helps families and children in need and also provides opportunities for individual Christians, congregations, and Christian businesses and schools to be a part of intentionally revealing this love to people in the community, especially those who need a helping hand, are hurting, distressed and are vulnerable.

Why?

Our motivation is partly summed up in Luke 10:25-37, where Jesus outlines some of what His people are to be doing while waiting for Heaven. In this parable, the man from Samaria provided costly, sacrificial, and thorough practical assistance to his enemy lying half-dead on the Jericho Road. It is a picture of what Jesus did for each of His people, and it is a call from Jesus to each one of us to, "Go and do likewise." (Luke 10:37)

Jesus wants His people to provide practical care actively, generously, and intentionally, for people in need in our community, and Jesus himself is our model of compassion and practical help.

Founded in 1968 in response to the undeserved grace and mercy Jesus has shown us, Temcare provides temporary practical care motivated by this everlasting love of Jesus. This is the love we desire to reveal to and share with others, through practical acts of kindness, care, and love, unashamedly provided in the name of Jesus. This can in turn provide hope for the hopeless, love for the unloved, and belonging for the lost and alone.





This practical Christianity in turn reveals Jesus to our wider community and brings glory to God. It presents the Church in a positive light to a cynical and misinformed world and provides many points of contact between the two, with all the individual, community, and nation-changing impacts this can have.

Christians want to be active in practical ways in their community and Temcare is a platform for churches across many denominations to facilitate this participation, for Temcare to be their partner in community outreach through mercy ministry services.

With its staff, board, good governance, accredited volunteers, church supporters, generous donors, and long history, Temcare is a platform from which to expand this mission together, God willing.





What Does Temcare Do?

Temcare provides a range of services for families and individuals in need within the Victorian community.

Temcare's programs aim to:

Strengthen core intrapersonal and interpersonal life skills for family members. Facilitate responsive and positive relationships between parents and their children. Reduce sources of stress for children, adolescents and family members.

Introduce clients to those aspects of the Christian faith that will enhance their interpersonal and intrapersonal functioning.

We believe that these program goals will be most effectively facilitated by:

Enhancing an individual's emotional and social development.

Supporting parents to provide appropriate levels of care for their children.

Improving social / emotional / educational / outcomes for children and adolescents.

Facilitating a person's interest in exploring matters of the Christian faith that are relevant to their overall well-being.

In terms of the latter, and only with the clear permission of the person, Temcare endeavours to assist parents, children and adolescents to:

Develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Become connected to and established in a local supportive church of their preference. Grow in their Christian faith journey.

Grateful that when God looks at me on that day, when I stand before Him to face judgement for my earthly life, He will not see me, He will see His Son Jesus Christ, who died on that cross for me, paid the price of my sinful life, so that I can be set free to live with Him for eternity in heaven.

So, dive in, love Him fiercely, and watch "all things" turn for your good. Following Jesus isn't about perfection; it's about progress in His loving hands. What a thrilling way to live!

Now, here's where it gets even more empowering: recognizing that God, through Jesus, is in complete control, turning potential disasters into divine victories!

If your loved ones know Jesus too, then it is only a relatively short period of time before you get to spend forever with them. So, pray and trust the One you are praying to. Jesus is trustworthy and He is loving.

And even now, in the midst of trials, Jesus infuses hope, making the unseen eternal shine brighter.

Following Him means viewing every moment through this lens: temporary troubles paving the way for triumphant eternity. What an invigorating perspective for a great life!

As we wrap up this exhilarating exploration, let's zoom in on why Jesus is hands-down the best cause to follow for a truly great life.

In Temcare's inspiring work, helping families thrive since 1968 through practical support like Christmas and food hampers, camps, sporting opportunities, respite care, mentoring, and friendship, we see glimpses of Jesus' love in action.

But the real game-changer? Eternal hope in Him!

John 3:16 says it all: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." As J.C. Ryle wisely put it, "Let us see in every sorrow and trouble of our earthly pilgrimage, the hand of Him who gave Christ to die for our sins. That hand can never smite us except in love. He who gave us His only begotten Son, will never withhold anything from us that is really for our good. Let us say to ourselves in the darkest hour of trial, "This also is ordered by Him who gave Christ to die for my sins. It cannot be wrong. It is done in love. It must be well."

So, how do you get this adventure, this life of purpose, this eternal joy? Well, thankfully it is not dependent on anything we have to do. We could never earn it and we certainly don't deserve it.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF CHRISTIAN BRETHREN COMMUNITY CARE LIMITED

Report on the Financial Report

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report, of Christian Brethren Community Care Limited (the company), which comprises the statement of financial position as at 30 June 2024, the statement of profit or loss and comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity and statement of cash flows for the year then ended, notes comprising a summary of material accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the directors' declaration.

In our opinion the financial report of Christian Brethren Community Care Limited has been prepared in accordance with Division 60 of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012, including:

- a. giving a true and fair view of the company's financial position as at 30 June 2024 and of its performance for the year ended on that date; and
- b. complying with Australian Accounting Standards to the extent described in the notes and complying with Division 60 of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act Regulation 2013.

Basis for Opinion

We have conducted our audit in accordance with the Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report section of our report. We are independent of the company in accordance with the ethical requirements of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012 and the Accounting Professional and Ethical Standards Board's APES 110 Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (the Code) that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Australia. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to notes to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared for the purpose of fulfilling the directors' financial reporting responsibilities under the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of Directors for the Financial Report

The directors are responsible for the preparation of the financial report that gives a true and fair view and have determined that the accounting policies described in notes to the financial report is appropriate to meet the requirements of the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission Act 2012 and is appropriate to meet the needs of the members. The directors' responsibility also includes such internal control as the directors determine is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, the directors are responsible for assessing the company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the directors either intend to liquidate the company or to cease operations, or have no realistic alternative but to do so.

Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Financial Report

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion.

Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with the Australian Auditing Standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial report.

As part of an audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether
 due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and
 obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.
 The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for
 one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions,
 misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the company's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the company's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial report or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial report, including the disclosures, and whether the financial report represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
